

SGA Bill No. 05-07-F

A bill to amend Article IV, Section 1, Sub-section C, Part 3 of the Middle Tennessee State University Student Government Association Constitution to replace the stipulation of completing two (2) consecutive semesters with a stipulation of completing a single (1) semester.

Whereas: In the future (Fall 2008) a transfer student would be enabled to run for an Executive office,

Whereas: Transfer students would be encouraged to be more active in the Student Government Association,

Whereas: This would allow a new diversity of ideas from other universities and community colleges,

Whereas: Students would be alleviated of the pressure to choose Middle Tennessee State University as their first university amongst financial and geographical forces without worry of coming in as a transfer student,

Whereas: Transfer students would be given time to integrate with the Middle Tennessee State University population as a whole, making it feasible to be competitive in an election.

Line Item Veto

THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE 70TH CONGRESS OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF MIDDLE TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

Section 1: Article IV, Section 1, Sub-Section C, Part 3 of the Constitution of the Student Government Association of Middle Tennessee State University shall be amended to state the following: "Have *been* *enrolled* completed at least one ~~(1) semester in attendance~~ *two (2) consecutive semesters* as a full or part-time student at Middle Tennessee State University."

Section 2: Upon passing two (2) times in the Senate, this bill will immediately go before the entire student body in the form of referenda on a date set by the Election Commission of the Student Government Association. Upon approval it will take immediate effect.
