A Resolution Formally Opposing the IncludeEd Program

Whereas: The IncludeEd Program has been undergoing trials for implementation at MTSU and other TBR institutions.

Whereas: The goal of the Student Government Association is to protect the welfare of the student body.

Whereas: Basic free market principals inform us that with competition comes lower costs and better services.

Whereas: If implemented across campus, this program will deny students the right to shop around for a lower book price across multiple retailers.

Whereas: Most students prefer price over convenience and this program, if implemented across all sections, denies students the ability to make such a choice.
